

Child Find Activities for Pembina Special Education Cooperative

The staff of the schools within the PEMBINA SPECIAL EDUCATION COOPERATIVE conduct year-long voluntary screening of children aged 3-5 years who are not presently attending school and whose parents have concerns about their child's speech/language skills, school readiness, motor skills, social/play skills, behavior activity level and hearing. Scheduled screenings are held in the fall and spring of each school year, but parents may request a screening at any time throughout the school year. Qualified special education school staff will conduct the screening activities.
