Dear Educator:

AgCountry Farm Credit Service is awarding several \$1000 college scholarships. The scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who plan to enroll in college in the fall of 2022.

The recipient may be from an actively farming or ranching family or planning to pursue an agricultural career. This means that seniors from a farming or ranching family are eligible, regardless of their career intentions. Also, seniors intending to pursue ag careers are eligible, regardless of whether they have a farm background. In either case, scholarships are not awarded until the students show proof of enrollment in college.

**Application deadline is March 1, 2022.** Applicants must be residents of the following counties:
